

Our first year as a nonprofit, 2017

One year ago we (Minna Kayser, Cheryl Sivacek, and Karen Keegan) launched our 16-year-old inner healing prayer ministry as a 501(c)(3) organization. We established a five-member Executive Board, selected an Advisory Board, established by-laws, and attempted to project a budget for the year. Our mission statement "Redeeming the past through prayer" continues to provide direction for the organization.

STORIES. For those who like stories, we could tell you about the young boy Jimmy whose persistent suicidal thoughts ceased after one session with Jesus or about Connor who decided to renounce his involvement in the occult and follow God. We could relate the victories experienced by the Satanic Ritual Abuse survivors who pray with us regularly. Then there's John who has found freedom from his 20-year addiction to pornography and Judy who is no longer controlled by her father's anger. Each one is a testament to the power of God to change lives and restore broken hearts.

STATISTICS. For those who enjoy statistics, collectively the three of us logged in 648 hours of ministry with 41 people. This included three Intensives (3-7 days of focused prayer with 3 different people) and a very special opportunity of ministering to a dozen crew members aboard Mercy Ships when Karen went to visit her daughter in Benin, W. Africa. This first year the ministry was underfunded by \$15,000.
